

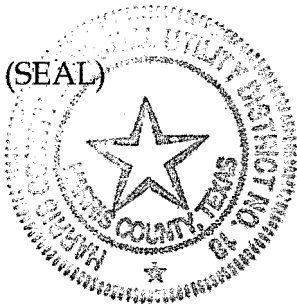
NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 18

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 18 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, June 12, 2017, at 11:00 a.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **San Jacinto Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Audit matters, including status of audit for prior fiscal year.
4. Authorize renewal of District's insurance policies, including review of engineer's list of District facilities to be insured.
5. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and review of capital projects.
6. Update on sales tax monitoring report from Sales Revenue Inc.
7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
9. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. design of District facilities;
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids;
 - c. review bids and award contracts;
 - d. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate;
 - e. update on Grant Road widening project;
 - f. service requests and repairs of District facilities;
 - g. water supply connection with North Harris County Regional Water Authority;
 - h. permitting, maintenance, and operation of storm water drainage facilities in Hidden Falls, including:
 - i. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance for construction of Hidden Falls Detention Pond rehabilitation/modifications; and
 - ii. authorize acceptance of deeds and/or easements;
 - i. capital improvement plan and project status summary; and
 - j. analysis of rates of water and sewer services.
10. Maintenance and development of proposed park tract.
11. Emergency Response Plans, including:
 - a. review District Internal Emergency Operations Plan and adopt Resolution Adopting Amended District Emergency Operations Plan; and
 - b. Emergency response training.

12. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance, correspondence, and message language on water bills;
 - b. report on surface water usage; and
 - c. Water Conservation Program.
13. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
14. Sale of Series B Groundwater Credits.
15. Receive updates and authorize appropriate action regarding the following:
 - a. North Harris County Regional Water Authority matters; and
 - b. Lake Forest Plant Advisory Council matters.
16. Constable security patrol matters.
17. Website matters.
18. Review action list.
